All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State aforesaid about four miles from the Greenville County Court House on the New Easley Bridge Road and known and designated as Lot # 5, as shown on Plat of the property of R. J. Sentell, made by Dalton and Neves, Engineer, in June 1934 and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin on the north side of Easley Bridge Road said pin being in a 12 foot driveway that separates lot no. 4 from lot no. 5 and running thence S. 177-30 N. 463.5 feet to an iron pin joint corner of lot no. 5 and Lot no. 6; thence S. 30-30 E. 153 feet to an iron pin on Easley Bridge Road; thence with the line of said road N. 58-45 E. 441.15 feet to the beginning corner.
