(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold, and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

Emily Hunt and her heirs and assigns forever,
All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Town-
ship, Greenville County, State aforesaid about four
miles from the Greenville County Court House on the
New Easley Bridge Road and known and designated
as lot No. 3, as shown on a Plat of the property of R. J.
Sentell, made by Dalton and Neeb, Engineers in June,
1934 and being more particularly described as follows:
Beginning at an iron pin on the north side of Easley
Bridge Road, said pin being the joint corner of lot No.
2, adnt lot no. 3 and running thence N. 28-45 W. 234
feet to an iron pin, thence S. 51-35 W. 85 feet to an iron
pin corner of lot no. 4, thence with line of lot no. 4. S.
28-35 E. 224 feet to an iron pin join corners of lots
Nos. 3 and 4 in Easley Bridge Road; thence with the line
of said road N. 59-0 E. 85 feet to the beginning corner.
