All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land in Highland and Gassy Mountain townships, Greenville County, S. C. on Neal's branch of South Tyger River, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at at a sycamore on the east side of and on the bank of Neal's branch or creek, waters of South Tyger River and running up and with said Neal branch as a line 23.40 chs. to a branch; thence with and up said branch as a line 3.30 chs. to a stake; thence 18½ W. 3.50 to a stake on on a line of W. K. Robertson land, (now belonging to Landford and Kendrick); thence with the line of said lands in easterly direction to the Willis Barton lands (now belonging to Isreal); thence with line of said lands to G.
