E. L. Chiles, his heirs and assigns.

All our right, title and interest, each being an undivided one-sixth (1/6) interest, in and to all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate on Poole's Alley in the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid:

Beginning at a point on Poole's Alley at the line of other property belonging to E. L. Chiles and thence running along the line of said alley 44 feet, more or less, to a pin; thence in an Easterly direction 100 feet, more or less, thence in a line parallel with Poole's Alley 40 feet, more or less, thence along the line of E. L. Chiles 100 feet to the beginning corner, and being a portion of the property conveyed to R. Y.
