All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in Greenville Township, State and County aforesaid, about two (2) miles from Greenville Court House, lying south of the Laurens Road known as tract No. 1, containing nine (9) acres, as shown on plat made by R. E. Dalton, August 1921, and more particularly described according to said plat as follows:-

Beginning at an iron pin on the northwest side of a road leading to the property of W. G. Glenn Estate, and lying between Tract No. 2 as shown on said plat and the tract hereinafter described, and being the northeast corner of Tract No. 2 and running thence across said road S. 36-20 W. 127 feet to an iron pin; thence across said road S. 51-0 W. 400 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 34-40 W. 286.8 feet to a pipe in line of W. G. Glenn property; thence S. 88-0 E. 995 feet to a pipe; thence S. 88-0 E. 19.5 feet to a pipe in what is known as the McAlister Road; thence across said road N. 27-23 E. 241.8 feet to a pipe; thence again crossing said McAlister road N. 53-30 W. 684 feet to the beginning corner.
