**Hubert A. Lindsey:**

All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in Highland Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, and having, according to survey made by Penn Morrow, C. S. the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at a point in center of the State Road in line of property of W. R. Lindsey and running thence with the center of said State Road N. 12 E. 2.52 chains to a point in center of said road; thence with the corner of other property of the grantor herein; thence with the line of other property of the grantor in a westerly direction 175 feet to an iron pin thence still with line of grantor herein and running in a southwesterly direction 231 feet to an iron pin; thence still with line of said grantor S. 4 E. 1.10 chains to an iron pin in line of property of W. R. Lindsey; thence with line of the said W. R. Lindsey property N. 74½ E. 5.18 chains to center of said Road, the beginning corner.
