All our right title and interest to and in all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being in Greenville County, Chicks Springs Township, just south of the town of Greer, S. C., and fronting on the New pelham Road; having the following dimensions to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin at the South West corner of J. R. Bell lot on edge of New Pelham Road, go S. 82.20 E. 5.60 cns. to an iron pin in ditch at line of Johnston land; thence S. 7 E. with ditch and with Johnston line .90 links to iron pin in ditch; thence N. 82.20 W. 5.70 cns. to iron pin on edge of New Pelham Road; thence N. 2 E. 90 links to the beginning corner; containing one half acre more or less, according to a survey made by M.
