Eubank, her heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, forever, all that piece of parcel or tract of land containing Two Hundred and Forty (240) acres, more or less, on both sides of the White Horse Road and on both sides of Reedy River, in the County and State aforesaid; Beginning at a chestnut stump 3 x 0.m. near the White Horse Road, corner between Wesley Philips and J.M. Watson, thence North 40 1/2 East 2.97 chains to a rock 3 x n.m. in place of a persimmon 3 x 0.m. Cut down on said White Horse Road and corner of the same; thence South 72 1/2 East 2.97 chains to a small persimmon 3 x n.m.; thence North 8 1/2 East 17 chains to a double chestnut 3 x 3 x n.m.; thence south 70 1/2 East 17.60 chains to a stake ex 0.m. in branch; thence down said branch 4 8 1/4 East 2.50 chains to a stake 3 x 0.m. in said branch; thence down said branch North 8 4 1/4 East 2.71 chains to a stake 3 x 0.m. in Reedy River at the mouth of said branch; thence down said River South 49 3/4 East 3.36 chains to a stake 3 x 0.m. at the mouth of a ditch on the East side of said river; thence South 8 8 1/4 East 2.61 chains to rock 3 x 0.m. at the corner of Butler Watson's field; thence South 37 East 11.42 chains to small black gum ex 0.m. corner of Butler Watson, Wm H. McCarroll and Wesley Philips; thence with McCarroll's line South 65 West 1.55 chains to a Post Oak 3 x 0.m. down in a field; thence with said William McCarroll's line South 24 1/6 East 14.59 chains to a Post Oak 3 x 0.m. down in old road; thence with said McCarroll's line South 62 1/6 West 13.50 chains to a double chestnut 3 x 0.m. down; thence North 20 1/2 West 4.50 chains to a persimmon 3 x 0.m. at corner of old field; thence South 65 West 8.86 chains to a Red Oak 3 x 3 x 0.m.; thence South 17 1/4 East 2.90 chains to a sassafras 3 x 3 x 0.m., corner of Wm H.
