KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That Laurens Road Development Company,

a corporation chartered under the laws of the State of South Carolina, and having its principal place of business at Greenville in the State of South Carolina for and in consideration of the sum of Four hundred (\$400.00) DOLLARS,

to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee hereinafter named (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto W. W. Williams;

All those certain pieces, parcels or lots of land situate about 2 1/2 miles southeast of the Greenville Court House in Greenville County, South Carolina, known and designated as Lots Nos. 97 and 98 on plat of subdivision known as East Lynne and having, according to plat thereof recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book H, page 195, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the northeast side of Laurens Road at the joint corner of Lots 96 and 97; thence with said Laurens Road S. 55-45 E. 55 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 35-06 E. 200 feet to an iron pin at corner of Lots 88 and 98; thence with the line of lot 88 N. 55-45 W. 55 feet to iron pin at corner of Lots 89 and 97; thence S. 35-06 W. 200 feet to an iron pin on the northeast side of Laurens Road, the point of beginning.

These lots are conveyed subject to the restrictions shown on the recorded plat above referred to and in addition thereto, the following building restrictions shall be applicable.

- (1) Said lots shall not be sold, rented or otherwise disposed of to Negroes or persons of African descent.
- (2) The said lots shall be used exclusively for residential purposes.
- (3) No residence shall be erected on said lots costing less than \$1500.00.
