All that certain lot, piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina and County of Greenville, in Greenville Township, and situated just inside the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, and about two blocks west of East North Street, and being described as follows: Beginning at the intersection of two ten foot alleys and just west of the lot of the C. M. E. Church, and running thence N. 8-45 W. 40 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 81-15 W. 96 feet and 9 inches to an iron pin on a 10 foot alley; thence along said alley 54 feet to an iron pin at the intersection of two alleys; thence N. 72-45 E. 95 feet to an iron pin at the beginning corner; and being lot #6 according to survey made by C. M. Furman, Jr., August, 1923. Being the same lot of land conveyed to Home Building and Loan Association, a corporation, by Henry M. Thompson by deed dated February 22, 1934, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Book of Deeds "175" at Page 362.

Also: All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, just outside the city limits of Greenville, S. C. and fronting a ten-foot alley: Beginning at an iron pin on said alley at joint corner of Edwards and Austin, and running thence along said alley 34.5 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 81-15 W. 105.5 feet to an iron pin on ten-foot alley; thence with said alley 50.8 feet to an iron pin on Edwards line; thence with Edwards line 109.6 feet to an iron pin on the ten-foot alley at beginning corner, according to survey made by C. M. Furman, Jr., August, 1923, and being the same lot of land conveyed to Home Building and Loan Association by Colonel Smith by deed dated May 19th, 1931 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Book of Deeds "163" at Page 215.
