Release of Judgment

Office for Greenville County, from the lien of those certain judgments dated January 28, 1935, and August 20, 1935, and recorded in the office of the Clerk of Court, Greenville County, in Judgment Roll E-4734 and Judgment Roll E. 5150 respectively.
