successors and assigns, all those certain pieces, parcels, lots and tracts of land,
lying, situate and being in the State and County aforesaid, some within and some without
the city limits of the City of Greenville, and having the following metes and bounds:

Tract No. 1: Lots Nos. 1 and 2, Block "A", and located just outside the corporate
limits of the City of Greenville, in sub-division known as Norwood Heights, according
to plat recorded in Plat Book E, pages 216 and 217 (formerly 215 and 216), R. M. C.
Office, Greenville County, and being the same lots conveyed to me by G. W. Cisson, deed
dated November 12, 1932, recorded in Volume 144, Page 205, reference to which is craved
for metes and bounds.

Tract No. 2, Lot No. 5, located on the Northeast side of Pinckney Street, in the
City of Greenville, according to plat of property of W. P. McBee, recorded in R. M. C.
