(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

Daisy B. Draper the life estate which I heretofore reserved to myself in and to the following described real estate:

"All that certain piece, parcel and tract of land situate, lying and being in Paris Mountain Township, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and known and designated as a part of tract No. 2, according to a survey and subdivision of the Mary J. McNabb lands, made by W. A. Hester, October 30, 1922, and having the following metes and bounds and courses and distances as shown by said plat to-wit: Beginning at an iron pin in the Greenville and Pickens Road, at the Southwest corner of tract of 17.9 acres, conveyed to W. B. Brockman by Mary J. McNabb and David Brooks, and running thence along said road N. 70 1/4 W. 4.50 to a bend in said road; thence along said road N. 80 W. 6.11 to an iron pin; thence S. 16 1/2 W. 13.90 to an iron pin; thence S. 68 1/2 W. 3.04 to a cedar; thence S. 33 W. 8.45 to an iron pin; thence S. 19 W. 5.40 to stone nm. at branch; thence along the meanders of said branch in an easterly direction 11.30 to an iron pin line of J. P. Eppes land; thence along the line of the Eppes land N. 35-1/8 E. 29.50 to a stone in the Greenville and Pickens road; thence N. 69 W. 5.60 to iron pin at the beginning corner, and containing 42.55 acres, more or less,

I conveyed the remainder in fee to all of tract No. 2 to David Brooks by deed dated September 14, 1927, which is of record in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 124, page 393, and on July 18, 1928, in deed made by myself and by David Brooks we conveyed 17.9 acres to W. B. Brockman by deed which is of record in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in deed book 127, page 175, and it is the intent and purport of this deed to convey the life interest reserved to myself to Mrs. Daisy B. Draper in the remaining portion of "Tract No. 2"
