Edwin McJ. Meares, his heirs and assigns;  
All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville just outside the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, on the north side of Barnwell Avenue, being known and designated as lot no. 18 on a plat of the property of the Estate of J. Q. Donaldson, deceased, which said plat is recorded in the P. M. C. office for Greenville County, in Plat Book #, at page 284, and having, according to said plat, the following meter and bounds, to wit: Beginning at a point on the north side of Barnwell Avenue, and running thence along the front line of lots 17 and 18, 160 feet to a point in rear line of lot 38; thence along the rear line of lot 38, N. 84-51 W. 35.5 feet to a point thence S. 85-07 W. 36 feet to the rear point corner of lots 18 and 19; thence along the front line of lots 18 and 19, 153.7 feet to the north side of Barnwell Avenue; thence along the north side of Barnwell Avenue S. 84-51 E. 71 feet to the point of beginning.

Being the same lot of land conveyed to the grantor herein along with other property by Nannie D. Furman by deed dated September 10, 1935 and recorded in the P. M. C. office for Greenville County, in Volume 176, at page 284.
