Received of the American Telephone and Telegraph Company of South Carolina One + no/100 -- Dollars, in consideration of which we hereby grant and convey unto said Company, its associates and allied companies, their respective successors, assigns, lessees and agents, a perpetual right of way and easement to, construct, reconstruct, operate and maintain lines of telephone and telegraph, consisting of such poles, wires, cables, conduits, guys, anchors and other fixtures and appurtenances as the grantee may from time to time require, upon, across, over and/or under the property which is or is not owned or in which have any interest in the vicinity of Taylors, County of Greenville and State of South Carolina, under cultivation as Greenville Nurseries, and upon, along and/or with the right to trim from time to time, any trees along said lines, so as to keep the wires and cables clear at least thirty-six inches and the right to permit the attachment of and/or pass in conduit wires and cables of any other Company, said sum being received in full payment for the rights herein granted.
