Know all men by these Presents, that I, Fannie A. Gary, of said County and State, in consideration of the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar to me in hand paid by Duke Power Company, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant unto the Duke Power Company, its successors and assigns, the right, privilege and exemption to construct, maintain and operate a line of power on the street, shoulder or border thereof, in front of that certain tract or lot of land owned by the grantor, situated in the State and County aforesaid, lying on the south side of Buncombe Road at City Limits of Greenville, and bounded by Montgomery Avenue on the east and the lands of S. H. West on the west, and to construct and maintain in a proper manner, wires and other necessary apparatus and appliances for the purpose of transmitting power by electricity and to construct and maintain necessary trolley wires, spans, brackets and other necessary equipment across and over said street, and to use the same for the purpose of operating trackless trolley cars in front of said premises, together with the right to cut away and keep clear of said lines all trees and other obstructions that may in any way endanger the proper operation of the same.
