Dollars to it in hand paid, at and before the sealing of these presents, by


John M and Sweetie Dearing

a SPRINGWOOD CEMETERY having the following dimension, to-wit:

North eleven feet East sixteen feet nine inches  
Southwest eleven feet nine inches West thirteen  
feet six inches



In the right of way and cemetery purposes and to be used exclusively for the rights and purposes aforesaid, and subject to the conditions of the Charter of said grants, and of revisions thereto, and amendments thereto may be made thereto, and also subject to the Ordinances of said City, and the rules, regulations and by-laws of the City Council and Board of Health or Committee now in force, or which may hereafter be passed, relating to said cemetery and the burial of the dead therein.

NOTWITHSTANDING all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining,

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said premises, before mentioned, unto the said John M and Sweetie Dearing, their heirs and assigns forever;  
subject however to the limitations and conditions aforesaid, and imposed.

And it is done, hereby, and itself and its successors in office to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said Premises unto the said

John M and Sweetie Dearing, their

heirs and assigns against itself and its successors at other and against every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
