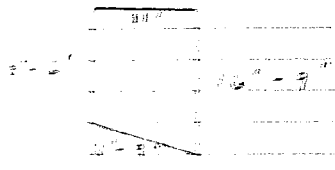

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the rights, members, appurtenments and appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said premises, herein mentioned unto the said John M and Lucette Fleming, their heirs and assigns forever;

subject however to the limitation and conditions hereinbefore imposed.
