FIRST: That their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND: That the name of the proposed Corporation is M & A. Alister, Smith & Pate, Incorporated. Divided into 50,000 shares of the par value of \$1.00 each.

THIRD: That the principal place of business is Greenville, S.C. at Columbia, S.C. on December 20th at 10:30 o'clock A.M.

FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is to buy, sell and deal in stocks, bonds and investment securities and to do any and all acts necessary or in connection therewith.

FIFTH: That the amount of the capital stock is Ten (10) shares of no par value

SIXTH: That the number of shares into which the capital stock is divided is Ten (10) of the par value of no par value

SEVENTH: That, after due notice, a meeting of the subscribers was held on the 8th day of June at which a majority of all stock in value being present in person or by proxy the following were elected directors: Joseph F. McAlister, W. W. Pate and Frank A. Smith

EIGHTH: That subsequently there was elected as President Joseph F. McAlister as Vice-President, W. W. Pate; as Secretary, Frank A. Smith; as Treasurer, Frank A. Smith.

NINTH: That all requirements of Article 2, Chapter 153 Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1925 and all amendments thereto, have been complied with, 50 per cent, of the aggregate amount of the capital stock having been subscribed by bona fide subscribers, 20 per cent of the capital stock subscribed having been paid to the Treasurer, and three days' public notice of the intention of the subscribers to incorporate in this State, and the name of the corporation, and the principal place of business, having been given in Greenville Redmont a newspaper published in the County of Greenville

NOW, Therefore, I, W. P. BLACKWELL, Secretary of State by virtue of the authority in me vested by the aforesaid Code and Acts amendatory thereto, do hereby certify that the said Company has been fully organized according to the laws of South Carolina, under the name and for the purposes indicated in their written declaration, and that they are fully authorized to commence business under their charter; and I do hereby direct that a copy of this certificate be filed and recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds, Conveyance or Clerk of Court in each county where such Corporation shall have a business office.
