All those certain lots on the North side of East Washington Street, Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being lots Nos. 11, 12, 1, 2, 5, 6, and 7 on plat of Christ Church property made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, September 26, 1936.

Lots Nos. 11, 12, 1 and 2 are described on said plat as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin at the N. E. corner of Church and Washington Streets and running thence S. 69 E. 229 ft. to an iron pin on the S. W. corner of Lot #3; thence with said lot N. 20-38 E. 170 ft. to an iron pin on said lot; thence with Northern line of lot #2 N. 69 W. 73 ft. to an iron pin W. W. corner of lot #2; thence with line of said lot South 20-30 W. 25 ft. to iron pin W. E. corner of lot #1; thence with Northern line of Lots 11, 12 and 1 N. 69 W. 155 ft. to an iron pin on Church Street, the North Western corner of lot #11; thence with a line of said lot S. 20-38 W. 105 ft. to the beginning corner.

Lots Nos. 5, 6 and 7 are described on said plat as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin on the North side of East Washington Street, being the joint corner of Lots Nos. 4 and 5; thence with line of Lots Nos. 5, 6 and 7 S. 69 E. 215 ft. to iron pin S. E. corner of Lot #7; thence with line of said lot N. 20-38 E. 200 ft. to iron pin, the North Eastern corner of lot #7; thence with Northern line of Lots 5, 6 and 7 N. 69 W. 215 ft. to an iron pin, joint corner of Lots 4 and 5; thence with line of said lots S. 20-38 W. 200 ft. to the beginning corner. This deed is made pursuant to a resolution of the Vestry of Christ Church adopted at a special meeting of the Vestry held on August 26, 1936.
