D. Jenkinson Estate, Plat of which is recorded in Plat Book H., page 207, R. M. C. Office for Greenville County and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin on the East side of Mc Daniel Avenue just without the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, which iron pin is 75 feet North from the corner of the Jenkinson Estate and property now or formerly owned by Jim Brown, and running thence S 68-16 E. 182.8 feet to an iron pin in line of Lot No. 6; thence N. 21-44 E. 146.5 feet to an iron pin on unnamed street; thence with said unnamed street N. 68-16 W. 215 feet to an iron pin on East side of Mc Daniel Ave. just within the corporate limits of the City of Greenville; thence with Mc Daniel Avenue S. 9-21 W. 150 feet to point of beginning. This being the same property conveyed to me, Margaret V. Rasor, by Calvin F. Seaguel by deed recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Volume 186 at Page 129.
