Kate Huggins, her heirs and assigns forever, all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State aforesaid about four miles from the Greenville County Court House on the New Easley Bridge Road and known and designated as Lot No. 2, as shown on a Plat of the property of R. J. Sentell, made by Dalton and Neves, Engineers, in June, 1934, and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin joint corners of lot No. 1 and lot No. 2 and running thence S. 51-36 W. 80 feet to an iron pin joint corner of lot No. 2 and lot No. 3, thence S. 28-45 E. 234 feet to an iron pin on north side of Easley bridge road joint corner of lot No. 2 and lot No. 3; thence N. 59-45 E. 80 feet to an iron pin joint corner of lot No. 1 and lot No. 2; thence N. 29-0 W. 244½ feet to the beginning corner.

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
