(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

Heyward Willimon, and his heirs and assigns, forever:
All those three certain tracts of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, known and designated as tracts Nos. 43, 44 and 45 as shown on plat of the property of P. F. and W. L. Cunningham, recorded in P. M. S. office for Greenville County in Plat Book "9" at page 269, and when described together have the following meter and bounds, to wit:

Beginning at an iron pin in the center of the intersection of Cedar Lane and Farr Bridge roads, and running thence along the Cedar Lane road N. 18.50 W. 158 feet; thence continuing with said road N. 26 W. 124 feet to an iron pin, corner of lot no. 54; thence with the eastern line of lots 54 and 46 188 feet to an iron pin in the center of Farr Bridge road; thence with the center of Farr Bridge road S. 63 1/2 E. 200 feet to the beginning point, said lots being a portion of the land conveyed to us by the Home Building & Loan Association by deed dated November 19th, 1936, and recorded in P.
