WHEREAS, P. D. Jones, Administrator of the Estate of Mrs. Dora J. Harris,  
sometimes known as Jane Hallman,

on or about the 9th day of December in the year one thousand nine hundred and thirty six did exhibit his Complaint in the Court of Probate, in the County of Greenville and State aforesaid for the sale of the Real Estate of Dora J. Harris, in aid of personal assets to pay debts of the deceased

Dora J. Harris (sometimes known as Jane Hallman)

J. E. Gosnell and E. L. Craigo  
for three Hundred Ninety (\$390.00) Dollars, being at that price the highest bidder for same.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said Guy A. Gullick, as Judge of the Court of Probate as aforesaid, in consideration of the premises, and also in consideration of the sum of \$390.00

Dollars, paid me by the said J. E. Gosnell and E. L. Craigo

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, Have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said J. E. Gosnell and E. L. Craigo

and their heirs and assigns forever, all that piece, parcel or lot of land just outside the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, beginning at the corner of Doe and Bob Streets, and running with Doe Street, S. 67 E. 39 ft. to iron pin; thence N. 23 E, 105 ft. to an iron pin; thence N. 67 W. 39 ft. to Bob Street; thence along Bob Street S. 23 W. 105 ft. to the beginning corner and being a portion of a lot bought by W. E. McCain from Frank Peters on March 29, 1910, and recorded in Book 8, at page 114, and being the same conveyed to Jane Hallman by W. E. McCain by his deed dated May 3, 1913, and recorded in the office of the R. M. C. for Greenville County in Book 18, at page 227."
