Paul E. Stewart, his heirs and assigns forever:

All that certain piece or parcel or tract of land, situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid in ONeal Township, and having the following lines metes and bounds to-wit: Beginning at an iron pin, on the Mountain View-Fews Chappel road and running thence North 21-12 E. 325.2 ft. to an iron pin, thence N. 43-15 E. 100 ft. to an angle thence N. 58-34 E. 78.3 ft. to an iron pin, thence N. 37-15 west 118.3 feet to an iron pin, in the center of plantation road, thence along said road N. 47-40 E. 100 ft. to an angle thence N. 60 E. 155.5 ft. to angle in said road; thence continuing along said road north 41 E. 509.4 ft. to an iron pin, thence north 12-15 E. to an iron pin in branch, thence up said branch north 14-15 W. 100 ft. to angle in branch, thence north 49-35 W. 200 ft. to a stake in branch marked OM, thence south 70-30 west 671.5 ft. to a stone OM, thence south 0-30 E. 1231.6 ft. to an iron pin on the Mountain View-Fews Chappell road, thence along said road south 47 east 108.7 ft. to the beginning point and containing 16.5 acres, more or less, according to a plat made by H. S. Brockman surveyor August 1936 and bounded by lands of J. A. Stewart, Mrs. Lillie Crain, Miss Anec Crain, Gilreath and L. K. Hall.
