All that certain piece, parcel and tract of land situated, lying and being in County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, on the West side of the White Horse Road, and having the following metes and bounds, courses and distances, to-wit: Beginning at an iron pin on the White Horse Road and running thence S. 50 W. 1785 feet to an iron pin on line of R. A.
