Belle Martin Sammons:

In Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on Mountain Creek, containing sixty-two and one-half acres, more or less, the said tract being a part of Thomas Taylor tract and a part of a tract formerly owned by Mary M. Raines, the two parts being combined, having such metes and bounds as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at a stone on mountain creek on what was formerly Joe Edward's line; thence north 37-1/8 degrees west 12-16/100 poles to a stone; thence north 59-3/5 degrees west 8.28 poles to a stone; thence North 45-5/8 degrees east 9.78 poles to a pine marker; thence north 16 1/2 degrees east 13.50 poles to P. O. marker; thence south 77-1/3 degrees 10.98 poles to a stone at the graveyard; thence south 32-2/5 degrees east 8.17 poles to a pine marker; thence south 56 degrees west 1.10 poles to a stone; thence with road south 19-1/4 degrees east 7.91 to bend in road; thence with road south 37 degrees east 10.50 poles to a stone; thence with road south 81 1/2 degrees east 0.63 poles to W. O. stump; thence south 66 1/2 degrees west 12.62 poles to a pine knot in n.p.; thence north 64 1/2 degrees west 3.85 poles to a pine knot; thence south 61 1/2 degrees west 8.41 poles to the beginning, this being the same property conveyed to J. W. Martin by deed of W. J. Gibson, executor of R. B. Gibson, and the heirs of R. B. Gibson and Theresa Gibson (ten in all) by deed dated May 15, 1897 recorded in the office of Register and Mesne Conveyance of Greenville County, South Carolina, March 22, 1909, and recorded in Book PPP, page 274, and entered on the said date in Book 2, page 121, to which reference is made for description and further reference.
