All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate lying and being in Paris Mountain Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, and located about three miles from the City of Greenville, having the following metes and bounds to wit:

Beginning at a stake in the center of old Parker Road at corner of property owned by the Grants herein and running thence N. 64-30 E. 493 ft. to stake, thence N. 46-36 W. 507 ft. to stake on Poor House Branch; thence S. 72-30 W. 121 ft. to stake on said branch; thence S. 86-00 W. 262.7 ft. to point at center of culvert where Parker Road crosses Poor House Branch; thence S. 30-00 E. 542.3 ft. along the center of old Parker Road to stake at point of beginning. The above course and distances being according to a survey made by N. J. Riddle, September 22, 1937. This tract contains 4.63 acres according to said survey.
