Office for Greenville County in Plat Book 3 at Page 102, said lot  
being more fully described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin on the North side of  
Argonne Drive, joint corner of Lots 17 and 18, said pin being 236.8  
ft. from the North east corner of Fair Rd. and Argonne Drive, and  
running thence N 48-50 E 175 ft. to line of Lot #15; thence S 41-10  
E 71 ft. to an iron pin, joint corner of Lots 16 and 17; thence along  
joint line of Lots 16 and 17 S 48-50 W 175 ft. to an iron pin on  
Argonne Drive; thence with the North side of Argonne Drive N 41-10
