All this certain piece, parcel or tract of land lying and being in county of Greenville and State of South Carolina in Cleveland Township, having the following metes and bounds respectively according to survey made by A. L. Hardin in October 1905 to wit: Beginning near old post on east side Matthews Creek on a stake at edge of bank near old fence to 24 35" N.E. 8° to rock on chestnut witness at field, thence - 57 S.E. 20° to rock near road at lower end field, thence - 35 S.W. 6° to stake on bank of Matthews Creek, thence up Matthews Creek meanderings about - 50 N 20 20° to the beginning corner. Bound on west by lands of N. B. Hardin and Matthews Creek a natural boundary on northeast by lands R. E. Johnston containing 14 a. more or less.
