*Mary Hall Provence, her heirs and assigns;*

All those five lots of land situated, lying and being in Greenville Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, being known and designated as Lots nos. 128, 155, 178, 179 and 218 on plat of *Shapler Park*, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book J, at page 116. Lot 128 fronts on *Park Drive*; Lot 155 fronts on *Byrd Boulevard*; Lot 178 and 179 front on *Mount-Vista Avenue*, and Lot 218 fronts on *Woodvale Avenue*.

The above lots all the same that were conveyed to North Carolina Trust Company by deeds of E. Inman, Master, dated December 8, 1930, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, in Deeds Volume 140, at page 259, and Deeds Volume 140, at page 260.

The corporate name of North Carolina Trust Company has, since the execution of the above deeds to it, been changed by amendment of charter to North State Improvement Company.

It is understood that the grantee is to pay the 1937 taxes on the lots herein conveyed.

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
