 All that lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, near Judson Mill, known as Lot no. 9 in plat of property of American Bank and Trust Company made by P. E. Dalton, Engineer and recorded in Office of P. M. C. for said County in Plat Book I, page 44, having a frontage of 49 feet on the south side of Judson Road, with a depth in parallel lines of 200 feet, bounded on the east by Lot no. 10, on the south by lots 18 and 19 and on the west by Lot no. 8 and being one of the lots conveyed to Cherry Investment Company by Julia S. Charles by deed dated June 1, 1932, and recorded in P. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Book 160, page 209.

Also that other lot of land in the Township, County and State aforesaid, on King Street, near the Anderson Road, known as Lot no. 14 in plat of lands of B. F. Martin by C. M. Thurman, Surveyor, from survey of G. A. Schulte, Surveyor, known as West View, said plat being recorded in the office of P. M.
