TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME:

I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County aforesaid, SEND GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, *Scottish Lumber and Trust Company, a Corporation, et al,*

on or about the *29th* day of *May* in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and *thirty four*, *made Dec. 29, 1934* exhibited *their* complaint in the Court of Common Pleas, for the County aforesaid, against *H. R. Keady, et al,*

demanding judgment in relation to the real estate hereinafter mentioned and described; and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the *14th* day of *April*, 193*6*, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a Decree

NOW, THEREFORE, Know All Men by These Presents, That I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County of Greenville, aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of *Twenty Five Hundred (\$2500.00)* Dollars, to me paid by the said *Sarah A. De Vane and Elizabeth De Vane, Rides*

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said *Sarah A. De Vane and Elizabeth De Vane, Rides*

*"All those certain lots, pieces or parcels of land situated lying and being in the City and County of Greenville, and State of South Carolina in the North Ward of the City of Greenville, known and designated as Lot No. 25 on plat of lot of Mrs. Annie G. Harris, deceased, made by Will D. Noney dated October 22, 1913 and recorded in the office of the P. M. S. for said County and State in Plat Book 3, at Page 261, fronting 60 feet on the south side of Harris Street and running back 114 feet or more to an alley, being the same lot of land conveyed to D. L. Stewart, by Mrs. Fizzie Stewart by deed dated January 27, 1917, and recorded in said office in deed book 44, page 57."*
