said J. E. Hall

"All that tract or lot of land in Greenville  
Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,  
in the City of Greenville, on Blinnie Street beginning  
at a stake in line of Blinnie Street, on the south side,  
16 feet 8 inches from the beginning corner of property  
described in deed from D. C. Linsell to Susan E.  
Mitchell, dated September 26, 1905, and recorded in  
Book 600, page 574, and running thence N. 61 1/2° E. 30
