South Carolina, in the City of Greenville, being Lot No. 3 as shown on plat recorded  
in Plat Book C, page 43, R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, and having the following  
metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning on Hampton Ave. 158 feet North of Frank Street, corner of Lot No. 3,  
and running thence with Hampton Ave. N. 33-35 W. 51 feet to corner of Lot No. 4; thence
