NOW, THEREFORE, Know All Men by These Presents, That I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County of Greenville, aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Thirty-eight hundred and no/100 (\$3800.00) Dollars,

to me paid by the said Jean M. Davis and Thomas Gordon Davis,

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said Jean M. Davis and Thomas Gordon Davis.

"All that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, in Greenville Township, having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
