demanding judgment in relation to the real estate hereinafter mentioned and described; and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 3rd  
day of February, 1937, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a Decree

NOW, THEREFORE, Know All Men by These Presents, That I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County of Greenville, aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of  
One hundred (\$100.00) Dollars,  
to me paid by the said Mrs. Sallie Alala

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the  
said Mrs. Sallie Alala,

"All that lot of land located at the corner of Vardry and Means Streets, in  
the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, and State of South Carolina, and  
having the following metes and bounds, viz:

Beginning at a stake or iron pin corner of Vardry and Means Streets, and  
running thence with said Means Street S. 28½ W. 70 feet to an iron pin corner of  
lot sold to J. M. McGee; thence N. 71½ W. with said McGee's line 150 feet to back  
line of lot sold to J. W. Henderson; thence N. 28½ E. with said J. W. Henderson's
