"All that lot, tract or parcel of land near the town of Taylors, South of Marrowbone Creek, on East side of Edwards Road in Chick Springs Township, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, adjoining lands of C. S. Hammett, Steve Johnson, Georgia Johnson and Bessie Bennett. Being a part of subdivision of the Wm. Shockley Estate, and having the following metes and bounds.
