the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said B. B. Hattler and The First National Bank of Greenville, as Executrix of the Will of R. D. Dobson, deceased

"All the right title and interest, the same being an undivided one-half interest of Clara Hoke, in and to the following described real estate.

All that piece, parcel and lot of land situate lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, near the Town of Greenville, on the East side of Broad Street and having the following lines and boundaries to wit: Beginning at an iron pin on Broad Street and runs thence in an easterly direction 204 feet to Hawkins' line; thence with said Hawkins' line 73 feet in a southward direction to an iron pin. thence westward 204 feet to an iron pin on Broad Street, thence with said street 73 feet to the beginning corner, bounded on the East by Hawkins' land, on the South by F. S. Bruce, on the West by Broad Street, and on the North by land of M. D. Littlefield.
