NOW, THEREFORE, Know All Men by These Presents, That I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County of Greenville, aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars, to me paid by the said J. B. Hall

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said J. B. Hall

"All that certain parcel or lot of land in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known as Lot No. 72, on plat of Pride and Patton Land Company, and being more particularly described by metes and bounds in said contract which is recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Vol. 64, at Page 596. Being the same tract of land conveyed to Rosalee and W. M. Holland by E. Inman, Master in and for Greenville County, South Carolina, by deed bearing date of September 1st, 1928, and being recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Vol. 130, at page 371."
