the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the
said Thos. J. Goldsmith

"All those two certain lots or parcels of land situate, lying and being in Greenville Township, County of Greenville and State of South Carolina, on the South side of Mountvista Avenue in Traylor Park, and being known and designated as lots Nos. 183 and 184 in said subdivision, as shown on a plat made by R. E. Dalton, Mar., 1923, which plat is duly recorded in the Office of the R. M. C. for Greenville County, S.
