all that piece, parcel or lot of land in..... *Greene*, Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:-
Commencing at a stake in center of C. & H. Division
of Southern Railway at corner of property of J. E. Rickey,
thence along line of Rickey property crossing the P. & T. Railway
N. 88° W. 591 feet to an iron pipe on the east right of way
line of concrete road, State Highway No. 2; thence along the
east side of right-of-way of said road S. 14-30 W. 261 feet to a
bend; thence continuing with said right-of-way line S. 6-20 W.
284.7 feet to an iron pipe, corner of property of J. S. Payne; thence
along line of J. S. Payne S. 88° E. 557 feet to a point in C. & H.
R.R. of Southern Railway; thence along center of said Railway
N. 6-27 E. 60 feet to a stake N. 11-57 E. 3.75 feet to a stake in
center of railroad; N. 17-02 E. 241.8 feet to the stake at point of
beginning.
