in consideration of the sum of Four hundred and no/100 (\$400.00)

to us paid by W. Snell Thackston

in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain sell and release, unto the said W. Snell Thackston, his heirs and assigns forever:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Fairview Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, containing two and Twenty three Hundredths (2.23) acres and more particularly described by plat made by W. J. Riddle November 11, 1936, and having the following metes and bounds according to said plat;

Beginning at an iron pin, joint corner of lands of W. Snell Thackston and Mrs. E. A. Edwards, and running thence S. 24-45 W. 913 feet to a point in center of road between lands of W. Snell Thackston and P. A. Green; thence in said road N. 45 W. 56.7 feet to a point in center of Jones or Holland's Mill Road; thence in center of said road N. 17-30 E. 938 feet to a point in road; thence S. 47-00 E. 166 feet to the beginning corner, bounded on North by E.
