All that certain piece, parcel and lot of land situate in the County and State
aforesaid, about one half mile from the limits of the City of Greenville near
Pendleton Road and described further as lot number thirteen--Brandon Annex by Plat
recorded in R. S. C. Office of Greenville County, Plat Book C, page 173, having the
following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at a stake the joint corners of lots twelve and thirteen on Landall
Street and running thence with said Landall Street S. 77 E. Forty-seven feet to a
stake; thence S. 9-30 W. one hundred eighty-two feet and 7 inches to a stake; thence
N. 71 W. 68 feet and 8 inches to a stake; thence N. 9-30 W. 185 feet and 6 inches to
beginning corner.
