in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain sell and release,
unto the said..... Emily W. Traxler.

All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Greenville Township, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, about one mile South of the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, being known and designated as Lot No. 292 on a subdivision plat known as Traxler Park, which plat is recorded in the office of the R. M. C. for Greenville County, Plat Book "F", page 114, and having according to said plat the following metes, bounds, courses and distances:

Beginning at an iron pin on the North side of Rock Creek Drive, joint corner of lots 292 and 293, and running thence with said joint line North 25-23 West 250 feet to a stake; thence North 62-34 East 70 feet to a stake; thence with the joint line of lots 292 and 291 South 25-23 East 243.6 feet to an iron pin on the North side of Rock Creek Drive; thence with said Drive as the line South 59-17 West 70.3 feet to the beginning corner.
