All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Paris Mountain Township, Green-  
ville County, State of South Carolina, Beginning at an iron pin on line of B. F.  
Bridwell land, joint corner of tracts four and five and running thence with a line  
of Bridwell land S. 73 E. 8.90 chains to an iron pin; thence S. 13 W. 4.80 chains  
to an iron pin; thence S. 10 W. 11.13 chains to a poplar X3 MN. on a branch; thence  
with the said branch in a southwesterly direction to Hoopers Creek; thence with  
said Hoopers Creek in a southwesterly direction to the mouth of another branch,  
corner of Tract No. 4, thence with said branch in a northeasterly direction 24.80  
chains to a maple; thence N. 15 E. 13.87 chains to an iron pin in B. F. Bridwell
