to J. J. Gentry paid by Walter Stow

in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain sell and release, unto the said Walter Stow

All my right, title and interest in and to

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, outside of the limits of the City of Greenville, and designated as Lot #52 on a plat of 6 recent Tenney property, said plat being recorded in the R. M. S. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book C at page 137, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the West side of Johns Ave. joint corner of lots 51 and 52 and running thence north said Ave. S. 0-50 sh. 70 feet to an iron pin on said Ave; thence N. 87-28 sh. 108 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 4-2 sh. 78 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 16-08 sh. 4.8 feet to an iron pin, joint corner of lots 51 and 52; thence with joint line of lots 51 and 52 S. 89-10 E. 169.7 feet to the point of beginning. Being the same lot conveyed to C. J. Gentry by C. B. Martin by deed dated Nov. 30, 1922 and recorded in the R. M. S. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 75 at page 589
