Whereas, the members formerly composing the congregation of Paris Baptist Church at a meeting held on August 1, 1937, adopted a resolution acknowledging that the purchase price of the property hereinafter described was, at the time of the organization of said church paid by Maybelle S. Hatch out of her individual funds, and that since said date the said church has ceased to exist as a religious organization and therefore, directing that the said J. T. Lester, C. C. Roddy and Maybelle S. Hatch, as Trustees for Paris Baptist Church Convey the property hereinafter described to Maybelle S. Hatch in full satisfaction of all claims or indebtedness due her on account of having purchased the said property.

Now, Therefore, pursuant to the resolution above referred to, this conveyance is made to Maybelle S. Hatch.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, J. T. Lester, C. C. Roddy and Maybelle S. Hatch, as Trustees for Paris Baptist Church,

in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Dollars and the premises,

to Maybelle S. Hatch

in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain sell and release, unto the said Maybelle S. Hatch, her heirs and assigns,

All that piece of land in Block Springs  
Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, At  
Paris, known and designated as Lot No. 13, Block "B" as shown  
on Plat of lands of Realty Corporation, and being more partic-  
ularly described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pipe on Bullino Road 98 feet  
N. 70 W. from Northeast corner of said Road and National  
Highway, and running thence with Bullino Road N. 70  
W. 100 feet to iron pipe, corner of Lot No. 14; thence with  
line of Lot No. 14 N. 21 E. 159.8 feet to iron pipe in line of  
Lot No. 15; thence with line of Lot No. 17 S. 65.15 E. 77.5 feet  
to iron pipe; thence S. 12-53 W. 154.4 feet to the beginning.
