Dacus on the West, and the Piedmont & Northern Railroad on the East, and to construct and maintain in a proper manner, wires and other necessary apparatus and appliances for the purpose of transmitting power by electricity; and to construct and maintain necessary trolley wires, spans, brackets and other necessary equipment across and over said street, and to use same for the purpose of operating trackless trolley cars in front of said premises, together with the right to cut away and keep clear of said lines, all trees and other obstructions that may in any way endanger the proper operation of same. All poles to be placed as near as possible to property lines.
