

it necessary or convenient in the development of its said property to change the location of said line, that Duke Power Company will, upon notice in writing so to do, at its own expense and within 90 days' thereafter, make such reasonable change in location of the line upon the property of Saluda Land & Lumber Company as may be so requested by said Saluda Land & Lumber Company.

4. This agreement with all of its terms and provisions shall be applicable to, and bind, the successors and assigns of both parties hereto in the same manner and to the same extent as it applies to and binds the parties herein named.
